PREFACE

The Board of Supervisors of Nassau County has authority, pursuant to Article I-A, to adopt and amend Local Laws and, in the main, to amend the County Government Law of Nassau County, otherwise known as the Nassau County Charter, and the Administrative Code. The Board's periodic adoption of Local Law changes are reflected in the Compilation and marginal notes. However, with respect to Local Laws adopted by the Board of Supervisors which do not amend either the County Charter or the Administrative Code, no generally available printed volume contains these laws and, in an effort to accommodate the public, a new section of the Compilation has been prepared entitled "Miscellaneous Local Laws of Nassau County" and it has been divided among the titles contained in the following Table of Contents. Exact text of these Local Laws can be obtained from the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors although, in certain instances, the full Local Law has been set out. Kindly refer to the marginal notes for information.
